- ❖ Spearheaded advocacy campaigns against police extra judicial killings carried out by Police SARS operatives; such as killing of 20 detainees at the Awka CPS, Anambra State in November 2004 and killing and dumping of about 50 bodies of slain detainees in January 2013 inside the Ezu River in Awka South LGA, Anambra State (see Intersociety’s Special Report: the Untold Story of Ezu River Police SARS Killings: July 2017).
- ❖ Spearheaded advocacy campaigns for dismantling between January 2012 and May 2015 of most of the estimated 3,500 police extortionist roadblocks across Nigeria majorly concentrated in the Southeast Zone; following the release of a report on police corruption as human rights abuse carried out by myself on behalf of Intersociety in December 2011, using Anambra State and the Southeast Zone as a case study.
