**Presentation Of Our Historic Agenda For Permanent Resolution Of The Israeli-Palestinian Conflict And Comprehensive Reforms Of The United Nations**

Our research **Memo** to UN, attached below, is presented here to Your Excellencies for comprehensive evaluation and necessary action by Your Excellencies' Home Governments or Organizations. It was prepared by int'l justice and human rights; and security and safety departments of our organization. The referenced research **Memo** followed the 73<sup>rd</sup> Anniversary of the formation of UN marked with 73<sup>rd</sup> Session of its General Assembly which commenced on 18<sup>th</sup> September and ended on 1<sup>st</sup> October 2018.

The **Memo** was dated 9<sup>th</sup> October 2018 and entitled: **An Agenda for Permanent Peace in the Israeli-Palestinian Conflict & a Call for Reforms at UN**. It was earlier on 24<sup>th</sup> September 2018 released as **open letter to UN at 73**; targeting world leaders who converged at UN headquarters in New York and began their annual addresses at the UN General Assembly from 25<sup>th</sup> September to 1<sup>st</sup> October 2018.

The **Memo** seeks comprehensive reformation of the United Nations particularly the Security Council and its powers and functions as well as UN membership and its criteria and general roles including principles and purposes of the world body. The **Memo** also comprehensively and innovatively outlines far-reaching ways of permanently ending the decades-long Israeli-Palestinian Conflict.

The historic **Memo** was updated and sent on 9<sup>th</sup> October 2018 to its four main recipients, namely: **H.E., Maria Fernanda Espinosa (Ecuador), President of the UN General Assembly, H.E., Antonio Manuel de Oliveira Guterres (Portugal), Secretary Gen of the United Nations, H.E., Ambassador Nikki R. Haley, the outgoing US Ambassador to UN and immediate past President of the UN Security Council for month of September and H.E., Ambassador Sacha Sergio Llorenty (Bolivia), the incumbent President of the UN Security Council for month of October 2018**. The four letters have since been physically and successfully delivered to their recipients through our local contacts in New York.

Our singling out and writing Your Excellencies, out of 109 foreign missions or member-states of the diplomatic community in Nigeria and-out of the 193 countries of the world or Member-States of the United Nations; is in special recognition of the strategic importance of Your Excellencies' countries or organizations in the two subject matters under discussion especially with regard to the decades-long Israeli-Palestinian Conflict, dating back to at least 1948.

Instances of such preeminence importance of Your Excellencies' countries or organizations include their protagonist or antagonistic roles in the past decades in regional or global peace and security as well as healthy and unhealthy religious, social, political, economic, cultural and diplomatic policies and conducts around the world.

It has specifically been found by **Intersociety** that Your Excellencies' countries or organizations played one active role or the other and are still playing same in the Israeli-Palestinian Conflict; which is why we considered the important involvement of Your Excellencies as representatives of Your Excellencies' countries or organizations in possible permanent resolution of the referenced decades-long devastating Conflict.

We pray Your Excellencies to critically study the **Memo** and send same to Your Excellencies' Organizations or Heads of State and Government (executive and ceremonial presidents, kings, queens, prime ministers and the Holy Father) for their adoption in the comprehensive reformation of the United Nations and permanent resolution of the decades-long Israeli-Palestinian Conflict being proposed.
